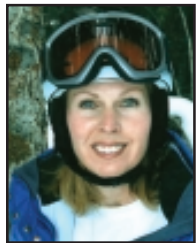

Colorado's world class premier ski resort is back this year. With over 350 inches of Rocky Mountain powder per year, Vail Mountain has your kind of skiing. If you like blue & green groomed cruisers, ski all day under the Eagle Bahn Gondola and stay warm on your return up the mountain, Oh! And it's only 5 minutes from our condo. Or maybe you want to stretch it out on a black, leading into a blue cruiser and ski for miles; well we got that covered too. But maybe you want some of that fresh powder in the famous Vail bowls, be sure to bring your ski legs, because you'll want to ski all day. What's that you say, you want to Race, how about the Blackforest NASTAR race course with its very own lift? And we haven't even talked about the trees yet, needless to say, whatever kind of skier you are, Vail has it, with extra to spare. 7 days at the Vail Spa just a 5 minute walk to the Lionshead Vail Square, and Eagle Bahn Gondola, every kind of restaurant you can imagine, with a free town shuttle just outside our door to take you into town. The night life and Après ski of Vail is tops, and the unique village and shopping will cap off beautiful days on the slopes.

LODGING: Vail Spa: At Lionshead - Vail Spa offers spacious 2 bedroom 2 bath and 3 bedroom 3 bath condominiums, with 2 swimming pools, one outdoor, and one indoor. With whirlpools, exercise room, steam and dry sauna, and get this: a certified masseuse available by appointment. For those of you wanting to rent a car, there is 1 free covered parking space per unit. 24 hour desk help is available, along with 2 grocery runs per day. Vail Square has become a new hub of activity and is only the beginning of the redevelopment of LionsHead. New Lionshead restaurants include Vail Chophouse, Blue Moose Pizza, and Centre V Brasserie. Existing restaurants in Lionshead include Billy's Island Grill, Bart and Yeti's, Montauk Seafood Grill, and Mezzaluna. Come explore the New Lionshead Village!
