## ASPEN Ski Trip December 12-18, 2015

22 members of the Jacksonville Ski Club traveled to Aspen Colorado for an early season ski trip. There were 2 new members from Tallahassee that met us at the airport. All of us were on a non-stop flight straight into Denver on Southwest Airlines. We then met another new member who had flown in from Fort Meyers. A private coach bus picked us up at the airport and then made a stop at Applejacks & King Soopers so we could pick of groceries for the week. Despite the snow heavily coming down for most of our drive, we made it safely to Aspen in a little over 5 hours. We got dropped off directly at the front door of our lodging, The Limelight Hotel. This is also where 1 other member who lives in Colorado, drove on her own to meet us there.
