Located in southwest Colorado's majestic San Juan Mountains and surrounded by the Uncompahgre National Forest, Telluride sits at an altitude of 8,760 feet and is surrounded by the largest concentration of 13,000 foot peaks in the country. What began as a turn of the century mining town, Telluride is now a top-rated ski town known for its laid back atmosphere. The National Historic District in Telluride is just six blocks wide and twelve blocks long, but is filled with colorful Victorian homes, clapboard storefronts, specialty boutiques, art galleries, gourmet restaurants, and historic buildings.

In addition to the historic town of Telluride, the resort area also has a unique and modern Mountain Village, connected to the town by a free gondola which provides travelers with unprecedented access to both areas. With 360 degree panoramic views of the mountains, contemporary shops, and eclectic eateries, Mountain Village is truly a skier's paradise. With more than 2,000 skiable acres, 4,425 feet of vertical, and terrain for skiers and riders of all abilities, it is no wonder that Telluride rates among the top ski resorts in North America.

LODGING: JSC will be staying at The Mountain Lodge, which is slopeside in Mountain Village. This property boasts ski-in/ski-out convenience, upscale amenities including outdoor hottub and heated pool, steamroom, on-site restaurant & lounge, wireless internet, ski lockers, full-service front desk, and private shuttle for access to Mountain Village. The property is also just a short walk to the Village Market and free gondola. All units are 2BR / 2BA, with full kitchen, separate living area, granite countertops, and a fireplace. MOUNTAIN FACTS: Telluride has 18 Total Lifts, including 2 high-speed gondolas & 7 high-speed quads and 127 Trails, of which 23% are Beginner, 36% Intermediate, and 41% Advanced/Expert terrain. The longest run is the "Galloping Goose", which is 4.6 miles long. Elevation at the Base is 8,725, with a maximum elevation of 13,150....providing for a 4,425 foot vertical drop. Average annual snowfall is in excess of 300 inches.
